INCREASE IN THE PETROL RETAIL MARGIN AND WAGE ADJUSTMENTS

INCREASE IN RETAIL MARGIN ON PETROL

In line with NUMSA, FRA and SAPRA multi-year wage settlement agreement signed on xx October 2016, the retail margin on all grades of petrol will be increased by 4.9 c/l from 161.7 c/l to 166.6 c/l with effect from 07 December 2016. This increase in the retail margin should be ring-fenced for the recovery of increased wages.
