NOTICE: 2022 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING NEGOTIATIONS

The current MIBCO Main, Administrative, Autoworkers Provident Fund and Motor Industry Provident Fund Collective Agreements will expire on the 31 August 2022 and MIBCO will commence with collective bargaining negotiations in January 2022. The process will lead to development of the Collective Agreements applicable to the Motor Industry for the period 01 September 2022 to 31 August 2025.
