NOTICE: REGISTRATION OF THE LIABLE PERSON FOR THE ADMINISTRATION

EMPLOYEE INFORMATION

PRIORITY: HIGH

As the 13B Administrator of the Motor Industry Retirement Fund (MIRF), MIBCO has initiated the **Employer Portal** to assist employers with complying to the legislative requirements of the Pension Fund Act, in terms of FSCA Conduct Standard 1 of 2022, of 19 August 2022 (Conduct Standard). The Employer Portal is available for use and employers are required to register a liable person to maintain employee information on the portal.

REQUIREMENTS:

Employers are hereby requested to register a person who will be personally liable (Liable Person) for maintaining employee information on the **Employer Portal**. The registration must be done within thirty (30) days of this notification, namely, before the end of day of 31 August 2024.

Registration is done by:

- Completing the 'Liable Person Registration Form' and establishment addendum (only complete the addendum if the liable person is responsible for more than one site):

- Emailing the form to <u>LiablePersonReg@mibco.org.za</u>.
- An email and mobile SMS message will be sent to the liable person to sign-up and login.
