NOTICE: TEMPORARY REMOTE WORKING ARRANGEMENT – 30 JUNE 2026

The Motor Industry is hereby informed of a Temporary Operational Arrangement that will be **implemented on Tuesday, 30 June 2026**.

MIBCO is aware of information circulating through various media and social media platforms regarding the anticipated National Shutdown Protest Against Undocumented Foreign Nationals scheduled for 30 June 2026. While there is currently no official confirmation regarding the scale, impact, or certainty of the protest taking place, the possibility of demonstrations, road closures, traffic congestion, public transport disruptions, and other unforeseen incidents cannot be entirely discounted.

As a precautionary measure to safeguard the wellbeing of employees and minimise potential travel related risks, MIBCO employees will not report to the office on 30 June 2026. Employees whose roles can be performed remotely will continue to work from home during normal business hours and will remain available via telephone, email, and Microsoft Teams.

This arrangement has been implemented to ensure the safety of employees while maintaining business continuity and uninterrupted service delivery. Stakeholders can therefore expect normal operational support and service levels, as MIBCO employees will remain available to attend to queries and business requirements remotely.

We do not anticipate any disruption to services; however, should you experience any difficulty in contacting a specific employee, you are welcome to contact the relevant departmental manager for assistance.

Normal office operations will resume on the next working day unless further communication is issued. We thank you for your understanding and continued support.
